A BIG thanks to everyone for working together to get moved in and settled. Move-in day can be a bit hectic, but when we all help each other, the work is a breeze!

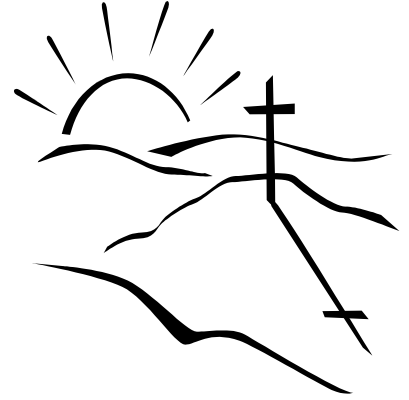

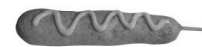
